Welcome to Calaway Park!

This guidebook provides information on the services, facilities, and policies that are available for all guests.

The following information is intended to assist you with determining your ability to enjoy each ride and attraction in a safe and fun manner! Your safety is our number one priority!

Attractions Boarding Pass

The Attractions Boarding Pass program is designed to provide access to individuals with special needs which prevent the individual from waiting in queue lines. This program allows for the guest to obtain a Boarding Pass to be used at the exits of rides, where the guest will be alternated into the front of the line.

All Guests requesting an Attractions Boarding Pass will need to show a valid **Access 2 Entertainment** card along with leaving a piece of collateral such as government issued photo ID or car keys with a Guest Services representative. Collateral will be returned when the Attractions Boarding Pass is returned at the end of the day.

Upon receiving the Attractions Boarding Pass, guests will receive an outline of the rules of the pass; and will be required to sign off that they agree to them.

If Guests have any questions or concerns during their visit, they can contact Guest Services at 403-240-3822 ext. 0.

Attractions Boarding Pass guests will be issued an orange paper wristband to identify them as an Attractions Boarding Pass holder. Fabric wristbands are available upon request for those with sensory sensitivities. The Designated Aide to the Attractions Boarding Pass guest will also be issued a blue paper wristband to identify them; and the wristband must be worn at all times.

Aide Responsibility:

It is understood that Aides assisting individuals with special needs are responsible for the individual with special needs' behavior and safety; and must be comfortable and competent in handling any situations that may arise during their visit. The Aide will make appropriate judgements on what rides are safe for the individual with special needs, and can load and unload the individual from each ride as needed and without additional assistance. Calaway Park team members are not permitted to assist in the process of physically loading and unloading individuals with special needs from rides.

The Aide is **required to ride** with the Attractions Boarding Pass individual on the following rides that do not have a locking restraint system: Timber Falls, Rocky Mountain Railroad, Bumper Boats, Carousel, and U-Drive.

Attractions Boarding Pass Rules:

1. The Attractions Boarding Pass is valid for the day it is issued, and must be returned to the Guest Services office at the end of your visit.
2. The individual with special needs receiving the Attractions Boarding Pass wristband **must wear the wristband** at all times and the wristband cannot be shared with others.

3. The Attractions Boarding Pass allows the individual with special needs and **up to 3 others in their party** to enter rides through the exit gate and will be able to ride the ride for one ride cycle. The individual with special needs who received the wristband **MUST** be riding the ride for the group to go through the exit gates of rides. If the individual with special needs is not riding, the group must wait in the standard queue.
4. **Only 1 Attractions Boarding Pass party (max. of 4 people)** will be permitted to ride a single ride at one time. Any additional parties with an Attractions Boarding Pass will have to wait for the next cycle available.
5. Individuals with an Attractions Boarding Pass are integrated into the lineup cycle.
6. Individuals with the Attractions Boarding Pass are to not ride the same ride repeatedly, and instead enjoy other rides/attractions in between.

Failure to follow the rules of the Attractions Boarding Pass Program may result in the confiscation of the Attractions Boarding Pass. Misuse of this program jeopardizes the future of the program and may result in removal from the park without refund.

Access 2 Entertainment

Access 2 Entertainment was created by the Easter Seals of Canada to help persons with special needs to enjoy recreational activities with an attendant without the financial burden. There is an administration fee to apply for the card; and you can choose a 3-year or 5-year expiration.

Persons with the Access 2 Entertainment card will also receive a discounted single-day admission to the park, and they are permitted one free admission for an aide!

Aides are required to be 18 years of age or older.

Services

Wheelchair Rentals

Wheelchairs may be rented from the First Aid office located near the front entrance to the park. Rentals are on a first come first serve basis for \$10.00 each. ID will be required to rent a wheelchair.

Guests may also bring their own wheelchair or battery powered vehicle. For those guests who choose to use a battery powered vehicle or wheelchair, we require a safe speed to be maintained while travelling in the park.

Guests Using Wheelchairs

On most rides where guests in wheelchairs can be accommodated, guests will need to leave their wheelchairs to be seated in the ride vehicle. In most cases, a wheelchair may be left near the ride platform or walkway near the ride. Almost every ride is wheelchair accessible.

If the guest has family members that wish to ride with the wheelchair-bound guest, they will wait in the line-up while the wheelchair guest waits at the exit. Once the family has reached the front of the line, the wheelchair-bound guest will enter through the exit and rejoin their party on the ride.

Lockers & Strollers

Lockers are available under the tower near the front entrance. Stroller rentals are available at Village Shop.

Restrooms

All restrooms have facilities designed for access to guests in wheelchairs located throughout the park accompanied with wheelchair accessible stalls.

Cash

Please visit the park map for ATM locations. Debit and Credit service is available at select locations. Please note: park locations do not accept \$100 bills. Please proceed to guest services to make change.

Special Dietary Needs

Calaway Park offers some food items for those guests that are plant-based or gluten aware. Guests with food allergies should know, all food locations are equipped with the detailed ingredient lists of every item that is served in that location. We'd happily share this information upon request. However, it is recommended that guests with severe dietary needs pack their own lunch because options are limited. Please visit Guest Services for a list of available items.

Lost & Found

Guest Services at the front entrance is the Lost and Found location throughout the day. Please note: we donate found items to a charitable organization after two weeks of being turned in. Calaway Park is not responsible for your personal property.

Service Dogs

Calaway Park welcomes guests with service dogs. Once you've arrived at the park, guests with service dogs will be directed to Guest Services. Guests are required to provide Service Dog ID cards under the Service Dogs Act. If you do not present a Service Dog ID the dog will not be allowed into the park. All service dogs should be kept on a leash or harness and remain under the guest's control at all times. Service dogs must be wearing an identifying assistive-companion vest. Due to the nature of attractions here at Calaway Park service dogs must remain with a non-riding member of the guest's party if the service dog is not permitted to ride.

Service dogs may accompany guests on the Balloon Ascension, Carousel, Rocky Mountain Railway, and U Drive.

Guests with service dogs will need to look at each individual ride or attraction listed in this guidebook to see if their service dog can accompany them onto the ride.

Sensory Backpacks

Supporting children living with sensory processing disabilities.

Free to sign out, use while you're here, and drop off when you're done.



Sensory Backpack

Please visit our Guest Services Office (located at the front of the park) during your visit, with a piece of collateral, to sign out a Sensory Backpack (including a fidget toy, weighted plush toy, noise cancelling earphones, and more) and return when you're done. Available for free on a first come, first serve basis.

Park Wide Policies

Parking

Parking for guests with an Accessible Parking Permit is located in the first two rows of the Sky parking lot next to the front entrance. Parking is filled on a first-come, first-served basis and may reach capacity on some operating days.

If the accessible parking stalls are unavailable, the Guest Drop-off & Pick up area adjacent to the park entrance may be utilized for ease of dropping off and picking up Guests.

Guests with a Hearing Impairment

For guests with hearing loss, all rides are equipped with a written copy of the rules. The written copy is available upon request from the ride operator.

Prosthetics, Casts & Braces

Guests with any type of prosthetics, casts and braces should note that all riders must have the ability to grasp with at least one upper extremity and have the ability to maintain an upright position independently while sitting. Should a guest with prosthetics, casts and braces not meet these requirements they will be unable to safely ride.

Smoking

For the health and comfort of our guests, smoking, vaping, and e-cigarettes are not permitted except in one designated smoking area beside the Haunted Hotel (must be 18+).

Consumption of marijuana is not permitted on Calaway Park property.

Please refer to the park map for the designated area or ask a team member for assistance.

Pregnancy

Guests who know or believe they may be pregnant should know riding most rides is not recommended. However, each pregnancy is individually different and those who are pregnant should visit a doctor before coming to the park.

Lost Children

When you arrive at Calaway Park, stop into our Guest Service office to retrieve a wristband for your child. Parents will be able to write their phone number on the wristband to make it easier for us to reunite you with your child should you be separated from them. This is a free program designed to enhance your worry-free day. Ask a Guest Services Representative for more details.



Rides & Attractions

All the rides and attractions at Calaway Park have rider requirements. These requirements exist in order to ensure that the safety restraints and devices are used as designed and to ensure that guests are capable of maintaining the proper posture during the ride.

Guests in wheelchairs can be accommodated on most rides, however they will be required to transfer from their chair onto a ride system. Calaway Park team members are not trained in transferring guests from wheelchairs and, therefore, are not permitted to assist you. They will, however, provide direction to the extent that they are able. We suggest that you visit us with someone who can physically help you when necessary.

Accessibility may vary depending upon special conditions; guests with casts, stitches or who have undergone recent surgery are requested to ask about any limitations that may apply. Please ask for assistance from the team member at each ride or attraction. All guests must meet all outlined height and weight requirements for each ride as posted in this guidebook, or at the specific ride location.

Attractions such as the Haunted Hotel may be difficult for some guests to navigate. An aide or other member of the guests' party should accompany them through this attraction.

Retail Shops & Games

Most of our retail and games locations are accessible for guests in a wheelchair. The following locations are not accessible due to stairs and tight corners; Twiz & Twirl Maze, Whac-A-Mole, and Mini Golf. Please see a Calaway Park team member for assistance if needed.

Restaurant & Food Locations

Some restaurant and food locations throughout the park may present difficulties for some guests in wheelchairs. Please see a Calaway Park team member for assistance if needed.

The Calaway Café and Riptide Grill are accessible to guests in wheelchairs and offers wheelchair accessible tables. Calaway Café and Riptide Grill team members will be happy to assist with restaurant orders and bringing orders to the tables.

CINEMAGIC 3D Theatre & Celebration Stage

Calaway Park's live stage shows and 3D theatre are accessible to guests with special needs. There are viewing areas to accommodate guests in wheelchairs although they are limited. Please ask a team member in advance for assistance with entrance and seating.











Cinemagic 3D Theatre – This air-conditioned theatre and family friendly 3D film is a great and easy addition to your fun filled day at Calaway Park. Wheelchair seating is available at the rear of the audience area. For guests with photosensitivity's talk with the team member to find out if the show is right for you.

Celebration Square Stage – An outdoor stage with live entertainment. All shows are approximately 20-25 minutes in length and are included with your admission.

Rider Responsibility

All guests have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while participating on a ride or attraction; and to obey all verbal and written warnings and instructions. Guests also have a duty to properly use all ride and attraction safety equipment provided.

All guests must adhere to the following at all rides & attractions:

-  No smoking, vaping, or use of e-cigarettes on the ride or in the line-up
-  No food or beverages on the ride or in the ride line-up
-  Riders must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol
-  Follow all height and weight restrictions
-  Follow the instructions given by the Ride Operator
-  Keep hands, arms, and legs inside the carrier for the duration of the ride
-  Remain seated and facing forward for the duration of the ride
-  Keep all restraints fastened for the duration of the ride
-  Children must be supervised
-  Loose items (hats, bags, phones, etc.) must be left with a non-rider

Guests who do not follow oral or written warnings may be removed from the attraction or from the park without refund.

Rider Restrictions

Calaway Park has a few general requirements which apply to all rides and attractions. All rides incorporate safety systems designed to accommodate average physical stature. Therefore, due to the nature and seating requirements of some rides, restrictions may apply. These restrictions may include; height, weight, body shape, medical conditions or other physical conditions that could be aggravated from riding. Our number one priority is for all of our guests to have a safe and fun experience!

Ability to grasp with at least one upper extremity: Guests must have at least one upper extremity that exhibits a good grip with the ability to brace. Upper extremity must be strong enough to remain in the correct riding position throughout the ride, where specified.

Ability to maintain an upright position independently while sitting: Guests must have the ability to remain in an upright position without the assistance of an aid or with a device. This is to ensure the guest can remain the proper riding position through the duration of the ride.

Vortex and Timber Falls: Guests must have at least one functioning upper extremity and one functioning lower extremity in which they can bear their own weight and ambulate independently. This is to ensure guests can safely be evacuated in the case of an emergency.

Loose Items

When planning your day at Calaway Park, we suggest you travel light. Calaway Park does not permit backpacks, purses, or any other loose articles on most rides. Items should be left in lockers or with a non-riding member of your party. Calaway Park does not permit the use of cameras or Go Pros while riding. Some items may be left on ride platforms; however, Calaway Park is not responsible for items being lost or stolen. Glasses and hats must be secured while on rides, as Calaway Park cannot guarantee retrieval of items lost on rides.

Shoe Policy

Shoes must be worn at all times while at Calaway Park, except for inside the CP Spray n' Play attraction area. We recommend that everyone visiting Calaway Park wear a standard, closed toed, running / play shoe. For the safety of your child, a standard play shoe, which is secured at the ankle and does not contribute excessively to the child's height, must be worn at all times unless otherwise directed by a ride operator. Platform shoes that increase the child's height are not permitted. Calaway Park reserves the right to ask that shoes be removed to ensure that a child's height is not enhanced or manipulated.

Parent Swap Program

The Parent Swap Program is an arrangement for parents with small children that want to ride a certain ride, but do not have provisions for childcare. When it is their turn to ride, one of the parents will wait with the child while the other rides, and then they will switch so that the other parent can ride on the next cycle.

Supervising Companion

Many of our rides have height requirements that allow guests under that requirement to ride with a supervising companion. A supervising companion is someone who meets all the requirements to ride the ride themselves and demonstrates appropriate behavior. The supervising companion must be seated in the same seat (row) as the guest who requires accompaniment.

Preferred Seating

In order to keep ride lines moving efficiently, guests may not wait in line for preferred seating. If a guest is at the front of the line and does not want to take the next available seat, they may go to the back of the line and try their luck for the next ride.

Emergency Stop

Please note that most of the rides at Calaway Park are equipped with an emergency stop button in case a rider needs to get off earlier than intended. However, depending on the type of ride, it may take up to a few minutes to bring the ride to a safe loading position. The following rides have the ability to stop almost instantly: Little Bucks, Dodgem, Hilltop Railway and Super Trucks. For clarification on the emergency stopping of any ride, please ask the ride operator or stop by Guest Services.

List of Rides & Attractions

Symbol Descriptions

Through-out this guide you will see the following symbols used to help guests in selecting rides that best suit their physical condition.



Ride entrance/exit is wheelchair accessible.



Guests must be able to transfer to the ride seating area with the assistance from another member of their party.



Ride is accessible by stairs. Guests are required to ascend and descend stairs.



Service dogs may accompany guests onto this ride.



Service dogs may not accompany guests onto this ride.



Ride is not recommended for expectant mothers.



Ride is not recommended for guests with a history of heart conditions or high blood pressure.



Ride is not recommended for guests with back or neck conditions.



Ride is not recommended for guests who are prone to motion sickness or dizziness.



Ride is not recommended for guests who have a fear of heights.

Ride Thrill Ratings

All Rides have been assigned a Thrill Rating based the nature of the ride. The Thrill Ratings are as follows:



Mild Thrill: Rides that are generally calm and gentle in nature. Ride is not likely to induce dizziness; there is no change in elevation; speed is generally slow, and motion is gentle.



Moderate Thrill: Rides that generally have low to medium speeds, with some elevation changes and moderate motion. Ride may induce dizziness; and riders may experience unexpected changes in speed and/or direction during the ride.



High Thrill: Rides that generally have medium to high speeds and/or heights. Ride may induce dizziness; and riders are likely to experience unexpected changes in speed, direction, and/or elevation.



Extreme Thrill: Rides that generally have high speeds and heights, with unexpected forces. Riders will experience many rapid changes in speed, direction, and/or elevation.

List of Rides & Attractions

◆ Adrenaline Test Zone

Test your limits at The Adrenaline Test Zone! A high thrill ride consisting of three arms that spin you around and lift you high off the ground!

Height Requirement:

Guests must be a minimum of 36" when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 48" to ride alone.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Bar and Lap Belt.

■ Aeromax

The sky's the limit at Aeromax! As the pilot of a crop duster plane, you will soar to heights of over 8 meters! Prepare for takeoff!

Height Requirement:

Guests less than 42" must ride with a supervising companion.

Guests must be 42" to ride alone.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Belt.

Airgliders

Be prepared for some high-flying fun! Air Gliders is a high thrill ride that takes you on a dizzying trip around in a circle as it lifts you up to the sky.

Height Requirement:

Guests must be 48" to ride alone.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Bar.

Baja Buggies

Time for some off roading at Baja Buggies! Ride your dune buggy on a 4x4 adventure geared toward kids, but kids of all ages and heights can enjoy!

Height Requirement:

Guests less than 32" must ride with a supervising companion.

Guests must be 32" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

There is a maximum of 4 adult-sized guests permitted to ride each cycle; and a maximum of 1 adult-sized guest per car.

Type of Restraint: Lap Belt.

Balloon Ascension

Take to the sky at Balloon Ascension, a relaxing family ride! Step into one of eight balloons that rise up into the air like a Ferris Wheel, and take you to the clouds. A perfect view of the Rocky Mountains!

Height Requirement:

Guests less than 48" must ride with a supervising companion.

Guests must be 48" to ride alone.

Bi-Planes

Dream big and fly high at Biplanes Stunt School! Kids get to pilot their own bi-plane as they go up, down, and around in a circle on what is sure to become their favourite ride.

Height Requirement:

Guests must be between 36" and 52" to ride.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Belt.

Bumble Blast

Buzz on down for the spinning family coaster, Bumble Blast! The whole family will be twisting, turning, and laughing all summer long on this figure-eight family coaster.

Height Requirement:

Guests must be a minimum of 42" when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 48" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

This ride employs safety restraints which may not accommodate certain people due to their body shape or size.

Type of Restraint: Lap Bar.

Bumper Boats

Splash, crash, and smile at The Bumper Boats! Hop in your motorized, inflatable rubber tube and steer, bump, and spray your way into tons of fun. A word of warning: you will get wet!

Height Requirement:

Minimum of 42" to ride when accompanied by a supervising companion.

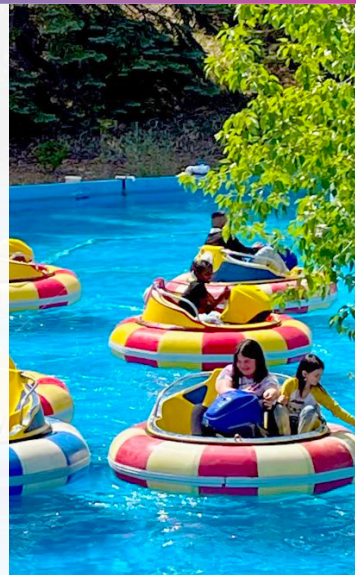
Guests must be 52" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

There is a maximum weight restriction of 275 lbs. per boat.

Additional Information:

Guests are required to squat into the boat and must be able to hold their own center of gravity. Guests with an Attractions Boarding Pass **must** be accompanied by their Designated Aide.

Carousel

Step back in time with The Carousel. An old fashioned merry go round with brightly colored horses, benches, and music. This is a ride the entire family can enjoy!

Height Requirement:

Guests less than 42" must ride with a supervising companion.

Guests must be 42" to ride alone.

Additional Information: Guests with an Attractions Boarding Pass **must** be accompanied by their Designated Aide.

Cinemagic 3D Theatre

Cinemagic 3D Theatre displays a family friendly 3D film in an air-conditioned theatre. Guests will watch a 12-15-minute film in a movie theatre setting. Guests are asked to remain stationary for the duration of the film.

Dizzy Dragons

Dizzy Dragons is a family ride that consists of 6 friendly dragons that spin as the ride turns in a circle. Control your dragon's turning speed with the center wheel, and be ready to whirl into fun!

Height Requirement:

Guest must be a minimum of 28" to ride when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 46" to ride alone.

Dodgem

Look out! Leave the rules of the road behind at Dodgem! These bumper cars allow adults and big kids to test their driving skills by weaving their way around others, bumping into whatever is in their way!

Height Requirement:

Guest must be 52" to ride this ride.

Type of Restraint: Lap Bar

Additional Information:

Riders are required to press and hold a button with their foot and turn the steering wheel of their car simultaneously.

◆ Dream Machine

Dream Machine is a family swing ride, which rises up into the air and tilts as it goes around.

Height Requirement:

Minimum of 42" to ride when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 46" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

This ride employs safety restraints which may not accommodate certain people due to their body shape or size.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Bar with a clip.

■ Eggs

I hope you're egg-cited for the Eggs Ride! Perfect for the whole family, it consists of 8 giant eggs on hydraulic arms that will raise and lower as the ride goes around. You will surely crack a smile!

Height Requirement:

Must be 42" to ride alone. Guests under 42" must ride with a supervising companion.

Weight Restriction:

Maximum weight restriction of 250lbs per egg. Guests may be required to split their group into separate cars in order to meet the restriction.

Type of Restraint: Lap Belt.

Flying Ace

Prepare to swing into action at Flying Ace! This family ride consists of a small rocking airplane that is good preparation for our larger Ocean Motion ride.

Height Requirement:

Guests must be a minimum of 38" when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 46" to ride alone.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Bar.

Free Fallin'

Elevate the fun over at Free Fallin'! This 40-foot drop will rise and fall multiples times, and will be sure to lift your spirits. Enjoy the great view from the top!

Height Requirement:

Minimum of 38" to ride when accompanied by a supervising companion.

Guests must be 46" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

This ride employs safety restraints which may not accommodate certain people due to their body shape or size.

Type of Restraint:

Shoulder Harness with a seatbelt.

Haunted Hotel

The Haunted Hotel is a spooky attraction that all guests can enjoy! Guests navigate through the dark hallways and explore the different rooms and lives of the Hotel's occupants.

Additional Information:

The Hallways are narrow with turns and uneven ground.

This attraction does not contain any team member jump scares.

Small amounts of theatrical fog is used in this attraction. Along with limited lighting.

Hilltop Railway

Choo Choo! All aboard for some Calaway fun at Hilltop Railway. A locomotive designed just for children, complete with an engine and a caboose!

Height Requirement:

Guest must be between 32" and 54" to ride.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Belt.

Little Bucks

Buckle up for some fun at Little Bucks! Our children's bumper cars allow kids to test their driving skills by navigating their way around others, bumping into whatever is in their way!

Height Requirement:

Guests must be between 36" and 52" to ride.

Type of Restraint:

Over the shoulder seat belt.

Additional Information:

Riders are required to press and hold a button with their foot and turn the steering wheel of their car simultaneously.

Mini Express

Come on down to Mini Express, our mini rollercoaster that is sure to put a giant smile on your face! Take a ride through the hills and turns on this exciting track, and soon your little ones will be ready for the Vortex!

Height Requirement:

Guests must be 36" to ride.

Weight Restriction:

Due to the size of the seats, there is a maximum of one adult-sized guest per seat.

Type of Restraint: Lap Bar.

Ocean Motion

Ahoy there, matey! I hope you have your sea legs ready! Come aboard Ocean Motion to enjoy a high thrill ride where you are swung back and forth reaching great heights.

Height Requirement:

Guests must be a minimum of 40" to ride with a supervising companion and must sit in the first 4 middle rows.

Guests must be 54" to ride alone and sit anywhere in the boat.

Type of Restraint:

Lap Bar.

Riptide Racer

Jump aboard your rescue boat and ride the waves on Riptide Racer! This family fun ride navigates a circular pool while guests can turn their rescue boats to the left and right increasing the waves and the fun. Caution: you may get wet on this ride!

Height Requirement:

Guests must be a minimum of 40" to ride with a supervising companion.

Guests must be a minimum of 52" to ride alone.

Weight Restriction:

There is a maximum weight restriction of 250lbs per boat.

Rocky Mountain Rail
